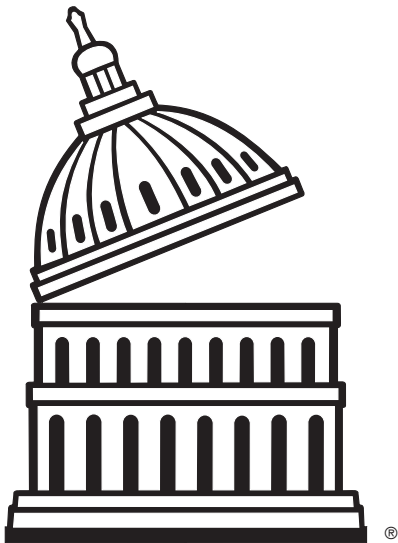

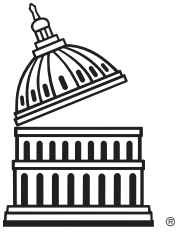

►Major Categories of Federal Government Employment

Special coded symbols preceding an individual's title are used to identify positions or individuals in the largest categories of federal employment outside the regular civil service.

Presidential Appointment

A bold star [★] preceding an individual's title indicates that the position is subject to Senate confirmation. An open-faced star [☆] preceding an individual's title indicates that the incumbent in the position is appointed by the President and does not require Senate confirmation. Positions of this kind are especially prevalent in the Executive Office of the President.

Senior Executive Service

The Senior Executive Service (SES) is a personnel system covering top-level executive, policy-making, managerial and supervisory positions. SES appointees do not require Senate confirmation, but their selection is regulated by the Office of Personnel Management. In the hierarchy of the federal government, SES members rank just below the top presidential appointees who head the departments and agencies. Positions may be specified as general (to be filled by either career or non-career SES members) or career reserved.

A bold dot [●] indicates that the SES member is a career employee. This means that the individual is filling a position in either the career reserved or general categories of SES employment. Career reserved positions are those positions that must be filled by career appointees in order to ensure the public's confidence in the impartiality of the government. Tax, law enforcement, and contract administration positions are typical examples. Career appointment to a position in the general category of the SES is identical to that in the career reserved category. There are limitations to ensure that most of the general positions are filled by career appointees at any given time.

An open-faced dot [○] indicates that the SES member is a non-career employee. Non-career SES appointees receive noncompetitive appointments to SES positions that normally involve advocating, formulating and directing the policies and programs of the administration in power or require maintenance of a relationship of trust and confidentiality with the agency's top executives.

Career Senior Foreign Service Appointment

An open-faced diamond [◇] preceding an individual's title indicates that the incumbent is a Career Senior Foreign Service member. Members of the Senior Foreign Service comprise the corps of senior leaders and experts for the management of the Foreign Service and the performance of its functions. Senior career members are appointed by the President, with the advice and consent of the Senate, usually through the promotion of career members of the Foreign Service.

Schedule C Appointment

An open-faced square [□] preceding an individual's title indicates that the incumbent in the position is appointed under Schedule C of the civil service rules. These regulations allow the Office of Personnel Management to be exempt from the competitive civil service positions of a policy-making role or positions that require a close, confidential working relationship with the agency head or other key officials of the agency. Schedule C appointees serve at the pleasure of the agency head.
