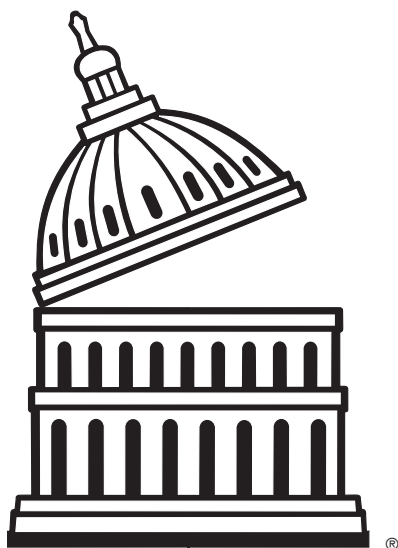

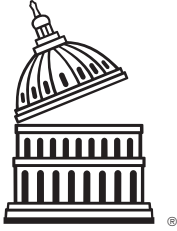

User's Guide

The *Municipal Yellow Book* is designed to give you direct access to more than 38,000 leaders in city and county governments and local authorities. The book is divided into three sections: Cities and Towns, Counties, and Authorities. Each entry lists the chief elected officials and their staff first, followed by other elected officials and departments in alphabetical order by office name. Each office is structured to show the hierarchy by office and job titles. Listings include:

1 Official name of the municipality, followed by the main address. In some cases, there is a brief note stating that city and county governments are combined.

2 General information, such as the county or county seat and whether elections are partisan or nonpartisan (consisting of ballots free from political party designations and affiliations).

3 Photographs of the chief elected official, when available.

4 Office name, with mailing address, general information telephone number, fax number, TTY number and e-mail address, when available.

5 Names and job titles of personnel listed hierarchically by job title, as well as a direct-dial phone number, fax number and e-mail address, when available. The expiration date for a term of office is included for elected officials. When an individual's address is different from the main bold heading, it will be included directly under that person's name.

6 Educational background, including school name, year graduated, and degree(s), when available.


7 Special coded symbols identify elected and appointed officials.

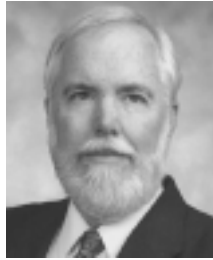
